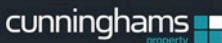

## **Queensie Patrols Outstanding in Trying Conditions**

Queenscliff members patrolling our beach have performed outstandingly well in responding to serious first aid incidents and trying surf conditions over the past fortnight.

On the last Sunday in March, Patrol 7 had to manage not one, but two simultaneous first aids requiring two ambulances. This included a very serious fin chop to the eye region of a surfer, which required the patrol's captain Natalie Bayly to attend administer first aid until paramedics arrived.

Whilst this was happening, Natalie's Vice Captains Kelly Beverly and Andrew Townsend were managing another first aid, as well as ensuring our beach remained safe.

That afternoon, Patrol 1 was needed to support the Lifeguards in preventing swimmers from being swept into a very strong rip only metres from the shore. Few will forget Mark Creighton anchored in the middle of the rip grabbing swimmers young and old as they started drifting out to sea. Thanks also goes to Matt Rowe, Ewen Litchfield, Todd Nevin, Justin McGirr and Linda Burrell among others who also helped to ensure no one was lost that day.

Last Saturday, Mark Clare-Nazer helped pull an unconscious surfer onto the shore, where Patrol 10 members including our esteemed President Kevin, along with Kimbyl Mann, Chris Corneil and Georgie Seaman attended to him until the ambulance arrived.

Special praise has to be given to Isabella Huggins, one of our newest SRCs who alerted the patrol to the rescue and helped get the Oxyviva and Defib for the Bronzies to use. Everyone was very proud of how well Isabella managed herself and the situation, and we are lucky as a club to have capable people like her on patrol.

Award is about celebrating youngsters who love sport, and that certainly sums up North Turrumurra nominee Logan Kaye.

It doesn't matter what it is, Logan will give it a go, usually finishing on top.

The Year 7 Trinity College student has had a busy start to the year, mainly with athletics, swimming and making a splash at local and state Nippers championships.

There's never a dull moment for Logan. He swims for Carilie Swim Club, runs at Bannockburn Little Athletics and competes for Queenscliff Nippers.

While he is still finding his feet at high school, the former Pymble Public School star has a long list of achievements after his first big achievements in Year 4 when he made it to PSSA State for swimming and cross country.

He backed that up the following year, representing his school at the PSSA All Schools Nationals for swimming, cross country and athletics.

Two national-level gold medals for swimming, three silvers and a bronze, as well as a gold for cross country and a bronze for athletics made it a special year.



Last year, he finished second in his age group at the 3km Open Water Swim at Nepean Regatta and picked up silver and bronze medals at the NSW Nippers Titles.

And he again picked up a swag off top-level swimming medals and showed that he's the kid to beat when it comes to cross-country.



Whether it's on land or in the water, Logan always puts his head down and does the best he can and said he hopes to one day compete in an Ironman Series and that his goal is to be a good role model for all children by loving sport and giving back whenever he can.
