LIFE SAVING EXCHANGE PROGRAM

As outlined in the Circular, the Lifesaving Exchange Program targets members who are currently Patrol Captains or identified to be future Patrol Captains between the ages of 18 and 30 years. The program provides participants with an exciting opportunity to experience different patrolling methods and environments in a fun, practical and interactive setting. The Lifesaving Exchange Program consists of two programs run concurrently on the Australia Day Long Weekend in January. The program is offered at no cost to the participant, with Surf Life Saving New South Wales covering the travel, accommodation and meal costs.

Applications will be assessed on their eligibility before being collated and forwarded to their respective branch for prioritisation based on their application answers and current involvement in Surf Life Saving. Each branch is allocated two spots on the program, however depending on nominations, more allocations may be provided to a branch.
