Your assistance in keeping these areas clean and tidy is appreciated. Thank you.



QUEENSIE MEMBER SELECTED IN AUSTRALIAN KAYAK TEAM

Queenscliff SLSC member KAILEY HARLEN has been selected in the Australian Junior Team to compete at the Kayak World Championships in Plovdiv, Bulgaria from July 26 to 29.

Sixteen year old Kailey joined QUEENSIE in 2013/14 as a senior nipper and competed in board and swim events. She commenced SKI training under coach Chris Allum when she turned 15.

Kailey took up Kayak paddling about twelve months ago and at the recent Australian Championships in the under 18 division gained first place in the K1 200, 500 and 1000, the K2 500, the K4 200, 500 and 1000. She finished 3rd in the K2 200 and 4th in the K2 1000 for a total of seven GOLD medals and One BRONZE.

It is probably over twenty years since Queenscliff had a member selected in an Australian Team (other than Surf Lifesaving).

Congratulations. Kailey from all at Queenscliff and we will be cheering for you in Plovdiv.
