CARYS BRADSHAW COURAGE AND DETERMINATION AWARD..

Last season, the Queensie community were deeply saddened to lose one of our nippers, the beautiful Carys Bradshaw. Whilst Carys lost her fight to an aggressive brain tumour her courage and determination will live on at Queensie. In memory of Carys' bravery this year we will award the inaugural "Carys Bradshaw Courage & Determination Award" to a nipper in each age group.

Age Managers will award courage and determination points each week to 3

nippers (1, 2 or 3 points). Points are awarded for showing determination to master a new skill or pushing through the fear of trying something challenging. At the end of the season the nipper in each age group with the most courage and determination points will be deemed the winner of the Carys Bradshaw Courage & Determination Award.
