An Advance Resuscitation Techniques Course (ARTC) is planned to be held at Queenscliff SLSC starting on Monday 16th February 2015.

The trainers will be Kerry Seipelt and Dave Torvell.

Its a 5 week course held on Monday nights with an assessment planned for Wednesday 25 March 2015 6:00 pm at North Curl Curl SLSC.

This course provides participants with the skills, knowledge and application of oxygen, airway management devices, and automated external defibrillators during resuscitation, and to administer oxygen to conscious and unconscious breathing casualties.

I just wanted to put on the record that these three young men did a wonderful job and were extremely professional on the scene. "
